TIPS FOR BOARDING

Feeding:

We prefer that you bring the food your dog is eating. This will limit the possibility of stomach issues while they are boarding. **Food needs to be pre-measured & each serving bagged individually in Ziploc bags. Please label everything.**

Medications:

Meds are to be in Ziploc bags & labeled with instructions & the pets name. Also please provide a way to administer the medication (cheese, pill pockets, wienies, etc.). Whatever works best for your pet. If your pet's medication is an injectable, please provide the syringes. Barkwood will not use syringes more than twice so bring enough to last during the whole stay.

Belongings:

Blankets & beds are not required. Barkwood will provide blankets & pet cots. Master suites come with custom toddler beds & bedding to match décor. We understand that bringing your own blankets from home can be comforting to your pet, but **please no oversized blankets/bed/crates.**

You may bring favorite toys, but limit them to **no more than 2 per pet.**

No bowls are needed. Barkwood provides stainless steel bowls that are washed & sanitized daily.

Barkwood Kennel Techs always do a great job in keeping up with all your pets' items. The more items brought the greater chance of something accidentally being misplaced. **Be sure to label everything that you bring with you last name & your pets name.**

Enrollment Information:

Please keep your pets information up to date. If anything changes please let us know as soon as possible. (Address – vaccinations – feeding – phones number – allergies – surgeries – medications – injuries – emergency contacts)

Let us know of any behavioral problems or changes to behavior since your last visit. (aggressive – destructive (chews) – digs – climbs or can jump fences)
